FedEx Breaks Ground on New Distribution Center in Quincy, Ill

General Information:

The foundation has been completed on a new FedEx Distribution Center in Quincy, Ill. The \$1.5 million, 28,000 sq ft center is located on 6 acres in Wismann Ridge Business Park (42nd & Wisman Lane).

Quincy City Planner Chuck Bevelheimer said the new facility will have parking spaces for 45 employees and approximately 20 trailers. The current FedEx freight location on Gardner Expressway and the Express Ship Center on County Road 735 East will not be affected, although a facility on Wisman Lane will relocate to the new center. The new site allows for future expansion.

Located on the Mississippi River, Quincy, Illinois, is the largest city within a 100-mile radius and serves as a regional hub for 600,000 people in Western Illinois, Northeast Missouri and Southeast Iowa.
