Access to markets: A new location for intersecting highways reaches nearly half the population and manufacturing capacity of the U.S. and Canada in one day's drive

Maritime: Northernmost port on the Mississippi River for 12-month barge traffic; The City of Quincy maintains a municipal barge terminal; Mid-America Intermodal Port Authority under development

Rail service: Burlington Northern Santa Fe and Norfolk Southern offer multiple freight trains daily; Two daily Amtrak trains to and from Chicago

Workforce: The largest city in a 100-mile radius, Quincy is a commercial hub for 600,000 people in Western Illinois, Northeast Missouri and Southeast Iowa attracting young professionals from the region's many colleges and universities

Regional airport: Baldwin Field Business Park provides on-site airport locations; Quincy Regional Airport offers six daily commercial flights to St. Louis

Midwest Controlled Storage: A 652,000 square foot, underground facility provides the flexibility to tailor areas to meet the customer's unique storage, fulfillment and distribution needs; Truck and rail served
