


Responses by Location

Top Community Strengths

The area's high quality of life and low cost of living remain the top two strengths in 2014. Building Availability/Cost replaces the Local Economy for the #3 spot and Community Leadership remains in the #4 spot.

Quality of Life 79% -1%

Cost of Living 53% -11%

Building Availability/Cost 43% +12%

Community Leadership Land Availability/Cost 36% +12%

Educational System Location 31% -8%

Top Community Weaknesses

Cost of Doing Business replaced Workforce/Labor Market as the #1 weakness, reflecting the continued need for improvement at the State level. The area's low unemployment impacts the availability of a qualified workforce which is why workforce development remains one of the region's top priorities.
