Concierge Program | Guest Application

Purpose

The Concierge Program is built through community partnerships -- a network of businesses and organizations with similar goals of fostering successful workforce solutions for building and retaining top talent in our region through a community onboarding process. Our services work to provide a direct connection to important resources and information for recruiting, moving and transitioning.

The Concierge Program is intended for newcomers, boomerang residents and those looking to plug into the Quincy & Adams County Community as a talent attraction and preservation program. We want to build a welcoming, inclusive and diverse community, which in turn fosters economic vitality for our region.

We want residents to feel welcomed and connected to the community and have resources needed to thrive.

Policy & Procedures

Community Concierge Program is offered in conjunction with existing talent attraction programs and begins prior to move in or employee first day. Businesses may use the Concierge Program as a tool to incentivize individuals and families to get to know the community. Businesses may also use the Concierge Program as part of new hire orientation for individuals and families.

A community resource guide is assigned to each individual or family based on needs and personal interests to connect with and follow-up with guests, for a 6-month minimum. There will be occasional, designated social events throughout the year, as well as other community events and activities to recommend to guests.
